

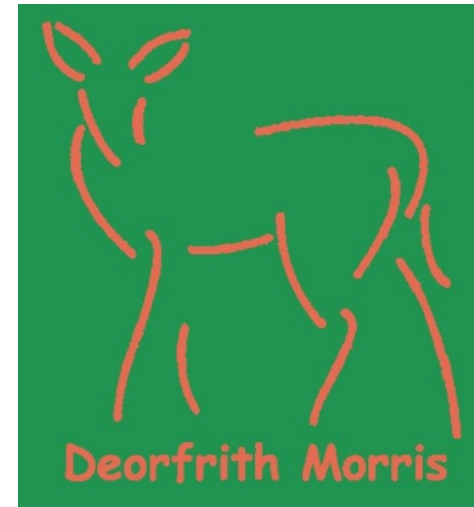
# Deorfrith Morris
